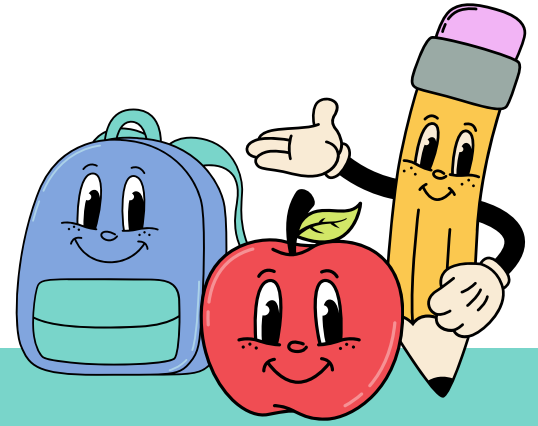


# Welcome Back to School
